Visiting the Fortnightly

LOCATION

The Fortnightly is located at 120 E. Bellevue Place in Chicago's Gold Coast, one block north of Oak Street, one-half block west of Inner Lake Shore Drive. View Map.

DIRECTIONS

By car: East Bellevue Place runs east-west, accessible from State and Rush Streets to the west and from southbound Lake Shore Drive to the east. East Bellevue Place is not accessible from northbound Inner Lake Shore Drive. From northbound Michigan Avenue, turn left at Walton Street to Rush Street.

By public transportation: CTA bus route #151 has stops at Union Station, Millennium Station, and on Michigan Avenue to Inner Lake Shore Drive. CTA bus route #36 stops at State Street and Bellevue Place. The CTA Red Line stops at Chicago Avenue and State Street and at Division and Clark. See rtachicago.com.
